- Has a distinguished record of achievement at the highest levels of competitive whitewater sport.

ADVOCATE

- Has promoted whitewater pursuits vigorously through grassroots advocacy, environmental stewardship or by producing significant products or services.
- Has served the whitewater community in a leadership role for a period of twenty (20) years or more.

Note: All nominees: 1) may be living or deceased, and 2) may be an individual or a team.
